All the things shown on this page can be found somewhere in the Museum.

They may be

- on the walls

- in the glass cases
- on the posters—or anywhere!

When you have found an object, tick the first column and write what it is in the second column. Ask if you are not sure.

	<p>This POSTER shows passengers the times and fares for a trip to the SEASIDE .</p>	
	<p>You would see this sign on an UNDERGROUND STATION in London.</p>	
	<p>These are finials. You would find them on the top of SIGNAL POSTS. SIGNALS tell the driver when to stop and when to go.</p>	
	<p>This is a gradient post. It tells the driver whether the line is LEVEL, or how STEEP a hill is.</p>	
	<p>You would find these block instruments in a SIGNAL BOX. They help the signalman to control the trains.</p>
