All the things shown on this page can be found somewhere on Ingrow West Station or in the railway yard.

They may be

- on the platform
- on or in the station building
- in the railway yard or sidings
- outside the Museum—or anywhere!

When you have found an object, tick the first column and fill in the blanks in the second column—one dash per letter. Ask if you are not sure.

	<p>At the end of the platform there is a sloping RAMP. Railway staff use it to get down to track level from the platform.</p>	
	<p>This is a POINT LEVER. It is used to change the point in the station yard.</p>	
	<p>This special point is called a double slip. It allows engines to shunt truck and carriages onto all of the different SIDINGS in the yard.</p>	
	<p>This BRAKE VAN is attached to the end of a goods train to help the driver stop the train.</p>	
	<p>These signs are from different railway companies. Find out in the Museum which companies they belong to. (LONDON AND SOUTH WESTERN RAILWAY; MIDLAND RAILWAY; LONDON AND NORTH WESTERN RAILWAY; GREAT NORTHERN RAILWAY)</p>
