	<p>This TAIL LAMP is hung on the last carriage or wagon of a train.</p>	
	<p>Every carriage has a NUMBER.</p>	
	<p>This DOOR HANDLE lets passengers open a carriage door from the inside.</p>	
	<p>This number 20 shows the SPEED LIMIT, which tells the driver how fast the train is allowed to go.</p>	
	<p>All railway carriages run on WHEELS.</p>
