	<p>This is a <b>BUFFER</b>, which stops one carriage from bashing into another one.</p>	
	<p>An engine puffs smoke and steam out through the <b>CHIMNEY</b>.</p>	
	<p>These are <b>CHAIRS</b>, in which the rails sit, to keep them fixed and level.</p>	
	<p>These <b>FIRE BUCKETS</b> contained water to help put out a fire.</p>	
	<p>In Victorian times only first class compartments had a <b>TOILET</b>.</p>
