	This is a model of a STATION .	
	Railway companies often put up a WAR MEMORIAL to honour railway men and women who had died in war.	
	Railway carriages often carried special DESTINATION BOARDS which showed where the train was going.	
	The guard was in charge of the TRAIN and the PASSENGERS. It was his job to keep them safe.	
	The guard also punched passengers' TICKETS with this special punch, to check that they had paid for their journey on the train.
